Matthew 10:32, 16:16; Romans 10:8-13

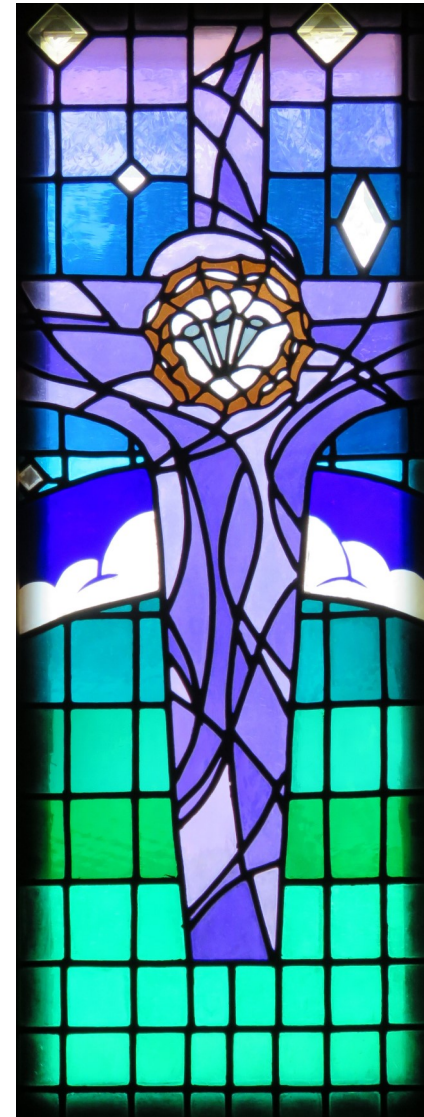
Be immersed into Christ for the forgiveness of sins
